

Horse Back Riding Bulletin

For the fifteenth year we are happy to offer English style riding at Undermountain Farm, a private stable on our street approximately three minutes drive towards Tanglewood. The stable is owned and operated by Yjasa Sprague, with an excellent, experienced riding staff. The Undermountain stable is clean and offers indoor and outdoor rings, as well as miles of local trails and a new jumping field. For the past nine summers, the program has been injury free, safe, educational, fun for the girls. Again, we will employ a horsewoman on our Belvoir staff to further develop and coordinate the growing program.

Charges will be added to your original bill and adjusted on the canteen bill paid at the close of the summer. All beginners will initially be taught privately and then moved into small groups. All others will be evaluated and placed in appropriate classes by skill. Girls who decide to ride should commit to riding at least one class per week for the camp season. Again, this year we are offering riding in the regular class day as well as on Sundays. Skilled and/or serious riders should elect the program as a class activity two or three times per week.

In addition to class training in the ring, the stable will offer trail rides, jumping lessons, some special events like mealtime rides, and for the ninth year, inclusion in a community horse-show with other camps. Advanced riders should therefore add boots, jodhpurs, and a shirt to the required riding helmet and shoes with a heel. Our costume room will provide a jacket.

To enable your daughter to participate in this program, you must sign and return the waiver below. Please note the waiver requires two signatures.

Undermountain Farm will take all reasonable precautions in the instruction of your daughter, but you must understand that she will be riding at her **own** risk.
